This Report it Form is to report Crime and **Hate Crime and Incidents**

The Report it Form comes with the Reporting Book

The Report it Form is to help you say what has happened

Use the **Report it Form** to **Tell someone** if something bad has happened. You can get help to Report it



Report it when:

- something is wrong
- someone has made you feel bad or you are hurt
- someone else feels bad or has been hurt
- a crime has happened
- you think it is a Hate Crime



Say No to Hate Crime

Report it

Tell the police if anyone hurts or harms you or someone else

If someone is hurt or help is needed fast

Do not fill in the form - get help first

In an emergency call 999





You are a witness • if you saw or heard it happen to someone else

You are a third party reporter or supporter • someone asked you to report it for them • someone told you about it and you want to report it

To help you Report it and to say what has happened you can tick the red boxes



It is best, to use your own words or pictures to say what has happened if you can. Use the empty boxes on each page to do this.

Information for Supporters and Third Party Reporters

Supporters

someone has asked for your help to fill in this Report it Form

Third Party Reporters

someone has told you what has happened and you want to Report it

This easy words and picture **Report it Form** is for people with learning difficulties and disabilities to report Crime, Hate Crime and Incidents.

You can use this **Report it Form** to report Disability Hate Crime. You can use the word only **True Vision Disability Hate Crime Reporting Pack** available from your local police or reporting centre or you can report online **www.report-it.org.uk**.

If someone asks for your help to fill in the **Report it Form** please make sure they can also look at the Reporting Book that comes in the Reporting Pack

This **Report it Form** aims to make sure that Disability Hate Crimes and Incidents are reported and recorded, crimes can be investigated, people can gain access to justice and victims and witnesses can be offered the support they want and need

The **Report it Form** can be used by the police and the Crown Prosecution Service as evidence so please give as much information as possible

If you or the person you are supporting do not want to talk to the police you can still use the form to say what has happened. **What you say may help other people**.

If you fill in the form and hand it to the police or other reporting centre, you will help the police, local councils, housing, social support and health services to find out what is happening in your local community. **They are all working together to stop Hate Crime**

Supporters

Send the form to the police **only if** the person you are supporting as victim or witness has said they want the police informed and they have filled in the **Contact me** section

Make sure the form goes to the agency or individual as stated by the person you are supporting and they keep the record of their report

If this form has evidence of a serious crime then it should be sent to the police for them to look at what has happened. Tell the person you are supporting if this needs to happen and please explain why you think you should contact the police.
