



CAMPAIGN AGAINST RACISM GROUP

CARG, Campaign Against Racism Group (formerly COVID-19 Anti-Racism Group) and was founded by a group of concerned citizens in April 2020 to address the rise of racism and hate crimes against the Chinese, East and Southeast Asian people in the UK due to COVID-19.

CARG seeks to promote social cohesion, diversity, and inclusivity by challenging racism and hate crime, especially against the East, South East Asian (ESEA) communities in the UK. CARG's work is primarily focused on policy to enable long term change and improved outcomes. We collaborate with other similar organisations for partnership working and mutual learning to raise awareness of the issues facing the ESEA community.

The group has since evolved and post pandemic, re-named Campaign Against Racism Group in keeping with the CARG acronym; with a focus on three focus areas of work to further support the community in Education, Mental Health and Policing.
